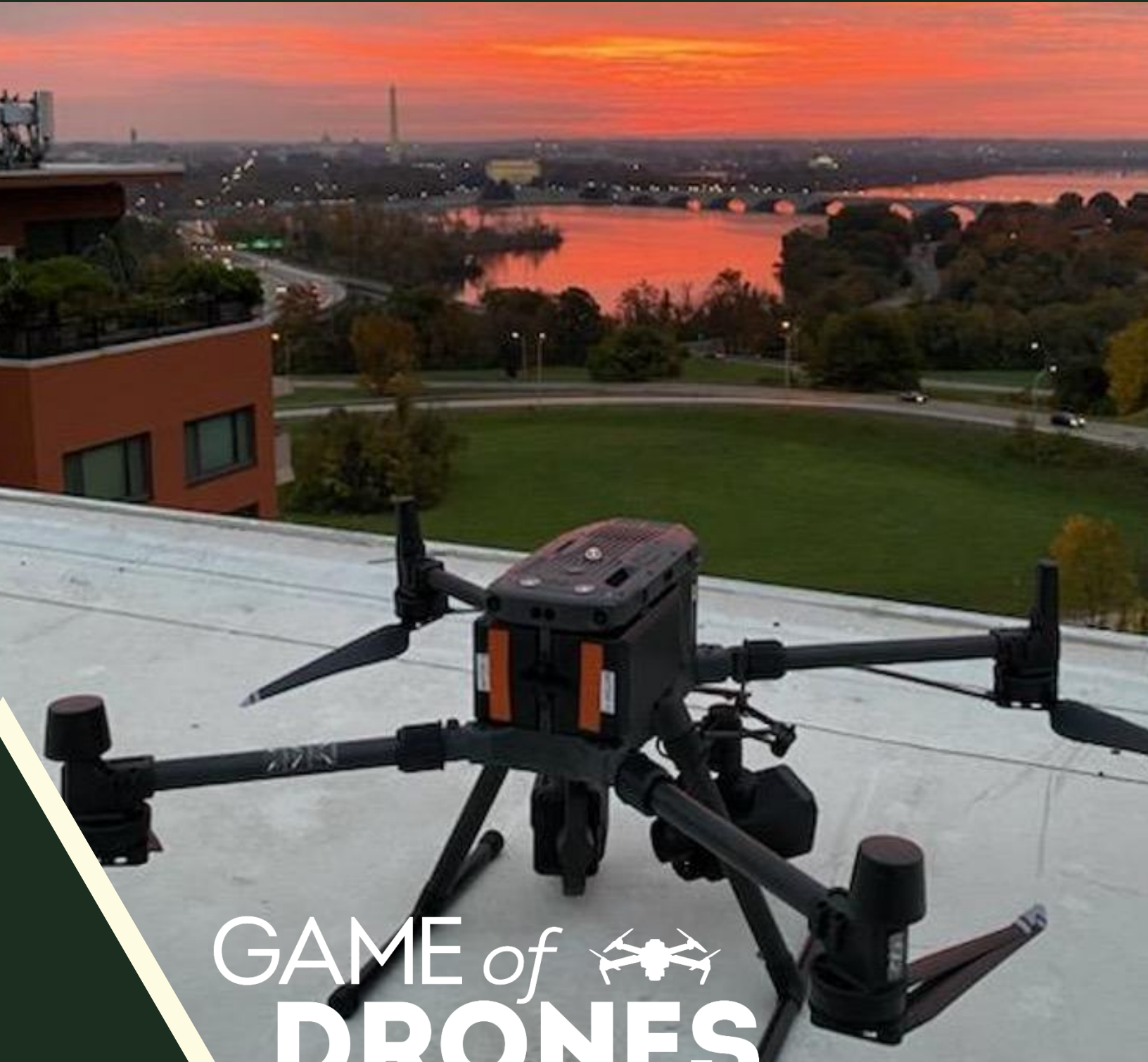

Game of Drones

The event will be the first of its kind, comparable to a law enforcement special weapons and tactics (SWAT) competition, that will bring together drone operators from across the nation for a skills competition. The event is scheduled for August 6-7, 2026, and will take place in Manassas, Virginia. It is anticipated that the event will include up to 150 public safety members, primarily from the National Capital Region (NCR).

Northern Virginia Emergency Response System (NVERS)

The Northern Virginia Emergency Response System (NVERS) is a 501 (c)(3) nonprofit partnership comprised of the region’s local governments and healthcare delivery systems. NVERS builds capacity and capability through regional collaboration, risk-driven investments, and strategic initiatives that enhance local emergency preparedness and response capabilities. This resilient partnership of public safety and healthcare delivery systems saves lives, time, and economic resources during major emergencies and disasters in Northern Virginia.

National Capital Region (NCR)

The National Capital Region (NCR) is comprised of twenty-one metropolitan Washington jurisdictions in Northern Virginia and suburban Maryland, in addition to the District of Columbia. The region carries symbolic importance as the physical center of American political and military power. It is also home to irreplaceable historical artifacts, major transit systems, high concentrations of military and intelligence installations, as well as significant critical infrastructure – data centers are one of the most recent additions to the landscape.

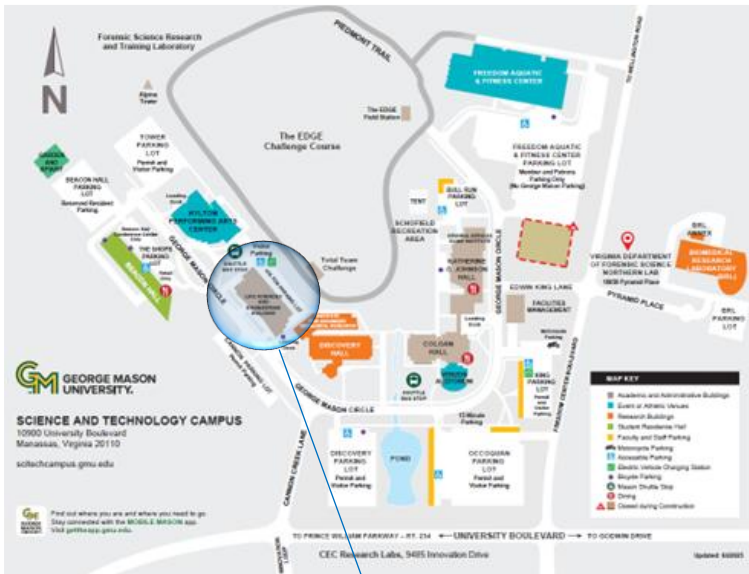
